

How to Use the Medicare Plan Finder



TIP: Before you begin, make a list of your medications including strength and daily dose

- 1 Go to [medicare.gov](https://www.medicare.gov) (If a **Make the most of your Medicare** window pops up, press Esc key on your keyboard to close it.)

- 2 Click **Preview 2020 Health & Drug Plans**. Click **Continue without logging in**.

- 3 **What type of 2020 coverage are you looking for?** Select **Drug plan (Part D)**; Enter your zip code and select your county and state from the list.

- 4 **Do you get help with your costs from one of these programs?** Select **I don't get help from any of these programs**. Click **Next**.

- 5 **Tell us your search preferences, Do you want to see your drug costs when you compare plans?** Select **Yes**.

- 6 **How do you normally fill your prescriptions?** Select **Retail pharmacy** for a 30-day cost estimate. Click **Next**.

- 7 Add your prescription drugs along with strength and frequency. Click **Done Adding Drugs** after all drugs have been entered.

- 8 Under **Pharmacy selection**, select two pharmacies. For the best pricing, include CVS and Walgreens to compare costs. One is likely to be a "preferred" pharmacy offering lower pricing. Click **Done**.

- 9 On the right side of the next page, next to **Sort plans by**, select **Lowest drug + premium cost**

- 10 The first plan listed should be the lowest cost plan that will cover your medications. Click **Plan Details** on the left side of the page for additional info.
